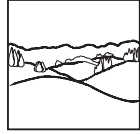

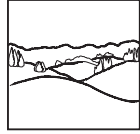

*Remi Leroy is an upstart Champagne producer to keep an eye on. His NV Brut is stunning & nuanced - a robust style showing red berries, brioche, underlying spice & lemon zest.*

*Balanced with notes of papaya & pear rounded out with hints of hazelnuts, finishing with crisp acidity & freshness.*
- Cava - NV Avinyo 'Brut Rosé'** Rosé of Pinot Noir 48  
*Bright red fruits combine with toast notes. On the palate, the wine is fresh & vibrant with light spicy elements on the finish.*

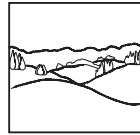

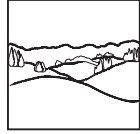

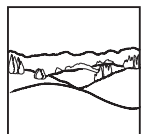
