**7 Tin City 'Dry-Hopped Cider' California (7.5%) 375ml** 8

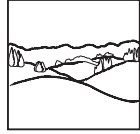
Full-flavored, crisp & refreshing made from apples grown just steps away from the production facility.

*Every great night (or morning) should start with Champagne, treat yourself to this balanced & complex stunner.*

- Rhone Valley - 2016 Eric Texier 'Adèle'** Clairette 5.5/11  
*Named for a French cartoon heroine, our new wine on tap is rich on the palate with lemon, lees & a lasting crisp finish.*
- Galicia - 2013 Ponte da Boga** Godello 6/12/48  
*A weightier white, this Godello is toasty with hints of brioche & apple blossoms as well as a cleansing sea salt caramel finish.*
- Dão - Casa de Mouraz** Portuguese Field Blend 5.5/11/44  
*A blend of 15 different varieties, Casa de Mouraz is Portugal's first Biodynamically certified winery & showcases the beauty of the Dão region as a whole with lemon peel, melon & mineral spice.*
- Beaujolais - 2016 Domaine de la Prébende** Chardonnay 7/14/56  
*A mineral driven Chard from Burgundy, this small producer uses stainless steel to give this leaner style clarity & dry finish.*

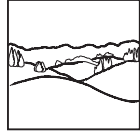

*We thought we had to wait until next vintage but our distributor found five more cases & we couldn't be happier to share the last of our Pastoral collaboration with Brooks Winery. Lush dark fruit, ripe berries, cinnamon spice.*
- Costa Toscana - 2016 Ampeleia 'Unlitro'** Alicante/Carignan/Alicante Bouschet 6/12/48  
*A true expression of the wild Mediterranean terroir of the Tuscan Coast. Savory notes of herbs & spices are joined by strawberry & cherry on the palate.*
- Roussillon - 2015 Domaine Le Bout du Monde 'Tam Tam'** Syrah 8/16/64  
*With only five cases in house, this natural wonder is alive & savory with black olive notes, pepper & a crunchy, earthy spice.*
- California - 2014 Vermillon 'California Red Wine'** Grenache/Mourvèdre/Syrah/Petite Sirah 8/16/64  
*A tiny production side project from Helen Keplinger. Deeply textured showing raspberry, blackberry, orange oil, violets & slate.*
- Mendoza - 2015 Graffito** Malbec 6/12/48  
*Jimena Lopez is the woman behind the vines making a powerful & densely vivacious Argentinian Malbec.*

<i>Remi Leroy is an upstart Champagne producer to keep an eye on. His NV Brut is stunning &amp; nuanced - a robust style showing red berries, brioche, underlying spice &amp; lemon zest.</i>	
<b>Champagne - NV Pierre Gimonnet et Fils 'Premier Cru' Chardonnay</b>	79
<i>This quintessential blanc de blancs has it all: light &amp; appealing mouthfeel, easy sippability with a crisp lemon finish. Another grower-producer showing off what they do best.</i>	
<b>Sonoma Coast - 2011 Ultramarine Rosé of Pinot Noir</b>	100
<i>Incredibly small production &amp; highly sought after - vinous with precise &amp; beautiful strawberry fruit.</i>	
<b>Champagne - NV Jacques Selosse 'Initial - Blanc de Blancs' Chardonnay</b>	220

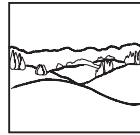

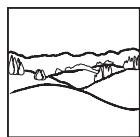

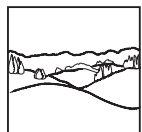
